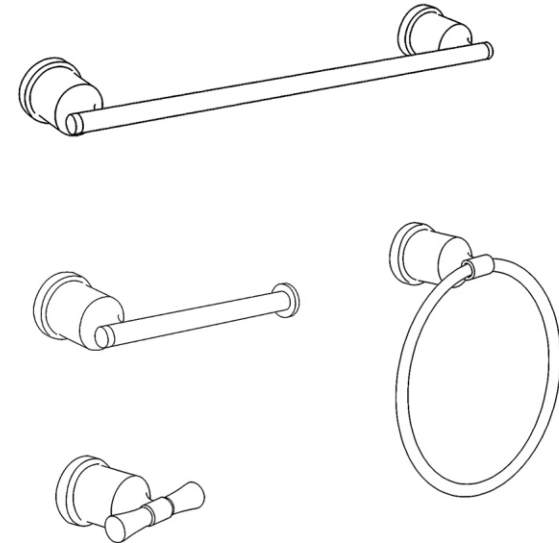

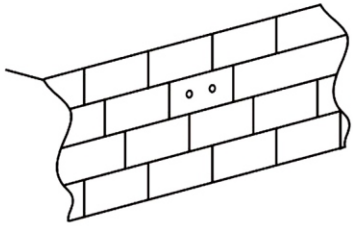

# INSTALLATION STEPS

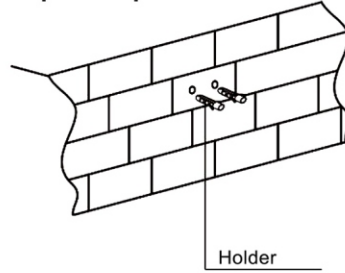
## BATHROOM ACCESSORIES

### Step 1/ Etape 1



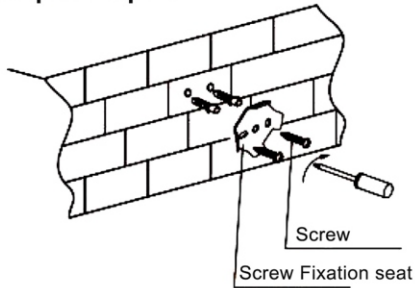
Refer to product size, drill 6mm holes on the appropriate position of wall surface.

### Step 2/ Etape 2



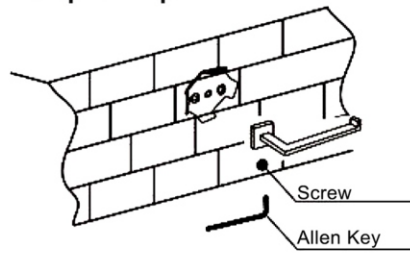
Hit holder into the hole.

### Step 3/ Etape 3






Use Cross screwdriver to tighten screw and fix bracket on the wall.

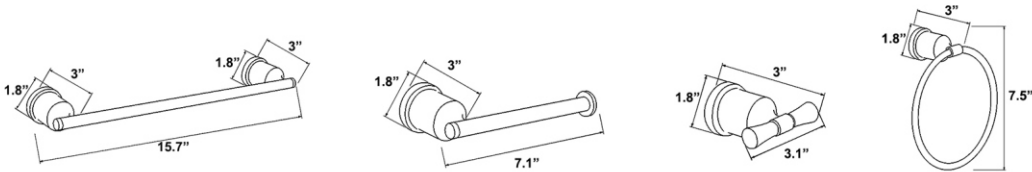
### Step 4/ Etape 4



Finally, hang the main body to thrust on the wall, tighten screws with spanner, confirm installation is reliable.

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## CLEANING CARE

In order to keep the product surface bright, please keep often or regularly to clean the product. Wash holder with clean water, and wipe with soft cotton cloth. Avoid using cleaning power, harsh cleaning chemicals, brushes, and cloth with coarse surface to prevent scratching and corrosion. Do not use acidic cleaning agents for washing the product as it may cause corrosion on the surface of the faucet in contact with harmful acidic agents.
